## From the Pastor's Porch:

What does it mean to be Christ Centered?

The officers of the church had a retreat in June, and in it, the concept of "Christ Centered" was presented from the book "Move."

As Christians (those who have faith in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior), we are called to be His disciples. Each of us. Christian and Disciple should be synonyms. If we are a Christian, we are called not to be baby Christians, but called to become "Christ Centered." Every youth and child in the church of course wants to grow up and become adults so that they will be mature.

Hebrews 6:1 "Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity."

If your elementary teachers let you stay forever in elementary school, did they do a good job as a teacher?

cold, I will spit you out of my mouth. For you say, I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing, not realizing that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and naked."

Lukewarm are people who aren't growing. If you are hot, you are growing in Jesus Christ. Otherwise, Jesus says you will be spit out!

Don't be spit out! As a church, we know the Bible is the word of God! Therefore, it is the truth!

My prayer for us as a church is that we are all growing. Each and every one of us. The session takes this very seriously and is working hard to create the steps and opportunities for growth for each of us. But the truth is, you have to want it. You have to feel the need to grow. You aren't going to grow unless you want to.

I cannot believe summer is already here! It seems like just yesterday that I was moving into my dorm on campus freshman year, but in reality I have just graduated from the University of Alabama with a Bachelor of Arts in both Communicative Disorders and Psychology. While it is bittersweet to be graduating and leaving the amazing city of Tuscaloosa, I am excited to see all that God has in store for me over the next year!

As many of you know, I am involved with an organization on campus called Campus Crusade for Christ (Bama Cru). Cru exists to introduce students to the authentic Jesus Christ, build them in Biblical teaching, and send them into the world as lifelong laborers for the Gospel. (You can find more info at <u>www.Cru.org</u>). Through this ministry my faith and willingness to serve the Lord have grown tremendously. One of the ways I want to do this is to glorify Him and make Him known to others throughout the world.

After spending six weeks last summer serving God in East Asia, the sweet people of that country will always hold a special place in my heart. Upon returning to the States, I knew that my mission there was not complete and that God was calling me to go back. Through Cru, I have the opportunity to do just that. After much prayer and consideration, I have made the decision to intern with Cru and return to East Asia starting this fall! I will be spending the next year (August 13th, 2016-June 15th, 2017) of my life overseas taking language classes, immersing myself into the culture, developing relationships, and sharing the gospel with other college students. Mark 16:15 says, "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to all creation." Through this internship with Cru, I am taking a step toward fulfilling this command.

I invite you to "go with me" as I embark on this journey. Our mission team NEEDS your support! Like many other mission organizations, Cru workers must raise all of their financial support. My support goal for this next year is approximately \$34,000, and my deadline for raising funds is August 1st, 2016. I am trusting in the Lord to provide the funds to cover the cost of this trip and I need your help! I ask you to prayerfully consider joining me as a partner in ministry by supporting me financially with a monthly or a one-time donation of \$25, \$50, \$100 or \$200, or some other amount.
