If he puts so much care and beauty into the nature He creates, how much more does He put into us, those created in His image! It is such a sweet reminder of how beautiful we are in the eyes of our Creator. The beauty of mountains is nothing compared to us!

The Lord has been so sweet to give me such great community over the past two years, and even though they weren't on my team, Courtney and Kelly have become two of my very best friends. Courtney served through the Auburn partnership at another location within our city, and Kelly served through the Florida partnership at another nearby campus. While I am so sad to be moving to a different city than all of my other teammates, I am so excited to have the opportunity to move to Birmingham with these two beautiful friends! 
