Luke 2

12 And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.
13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the **H**eavenly host **p****R**aising God, and saying,
14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.
15 And **I**t came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us.
16 And they came with haste, and found Mary, and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger.
17 And when they had seen it, they made known abroad the **S**aying which was told them concerning this child.
18 And all they that heard it wondered at those **T**hings which were told them by the shepherds.
19 But **M**ary kept all these things, **A**nd pondered them in her heart.
20 And the **S**hepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them.
