From the Session

Oh, that men would give thanks to the LORD for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men! Let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, And declare His works with rejoicing. Psalms 107:21-22 (NKJV)

The history of Thanksgiving actually began long before the Pilgrims landed in America. In England prior to 1536, there were 95 Catholic holidays (not including Sundays), where people were required to attend church instead of going to work. The Puritans wanted to eliminate ALL such holidays (including Easter and Christmas)! Instead, they

proposed ONLY recognizing Days of Thanksgiving (following the Autumn harvest) and Days of Fasting (after unexpected disasters).

After arriving in Plymouth in 1619, the 38 English settlers vowed that they would annually celebrate a holy "day of thanksgiving to Almighty God".

In 1621, following a good harvest, the Pilgrims' celebratory feast was shared with the nearby Native Americans who had provided them with food during the previous winter.

In November 26, 1789, President George Washington declared the first nationwide Thanksgiving celebration.

The annual day thereafter varied by state, but most celebrated it on November's final Thursday. That day had previously been called Evacuation Day, celebrating the day the British returned home after the American Revolution ended.

In 1863, President Abraham Lincoln officially proclaim d the above day to be the national Thanksgiving holiday.

He was strongly influenced by Sarah Josepha Hale, who had petitioned Congress for the previous 40 years to officially declare it!

On December 26, 1941, President Franklin D. Roosevelt set Thanksgiving to its current day, the fourth Thursday in November. (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Thanksgiving)

This month, America will celebrate its 402nd Thanksgiving!

Our dinners may be different from those of the early settlers, but our prayers should not. I thank God for my food, my abundance, my health, my friends, and my family. I am mindful of those less fortunate than myself. And I thank God for His great love for me, and His promise for my eternal life. Amen.
