May Celebrations

Time marches on and in the month of May. Mother's Day and Memorial Day are celebrated. The present day celebration of Mother's Day began in the year 1908, when Anna Jarvis organized a memorial for her mother Ann Reeves Jarvis. Ann Jarvis, a peace activist, used to care for the wounded soldiers of the Civil War. The event was held at the St. Andrews Methodist Church in Grafton, West Virginia, which currently holds the International Mother's Day Shine.

Anna Jarvis, an American woman, started the work of getting support for Mother's Day to be celebrated in the USA. She wanted to honor all the mothers of the world who have done a lot for their family and society. Because of Anna Jarvis' hard work, most of America's states by 1911 celebrated Mother's Day as a holiday locally (West Virginia was the first). The second Sunday of May was officially designated as Mother's Day in the USA, a national holiday. President Woodrow Wilson of USA signed the proclamation in 1914.

What does the Bible say about mothers? In the Bible there are many quotes and scriptures about motherhood, parenting and how to treat mothers. Passages describe the qualities of mother and encourage our mothers (Proverbs 31:25-31, Exodus 20:12, Leviticus 19:3). There are verses about mother's love. Isaiah 66:13 and 1 Thessalonians 2:7-8 describe mother's responsibilities and wisdom. The Bible asks mothers to raise their children with wisdom and to instruct them in God's word (Proverbs 22:6).

Memorial Day will be observed on Monday, May 30th in remembrance of the men and women who died servicing this country while in the military service. In 1971 Memorial Day became a national holiday by an act of congress.

It originated during the American Civil War, when people would place flowers on the graves of those who had been killed in battle. It was observed with laying of a wreath in Arlington National Cemetery in Virginia and by religious services, parades and speeches nationwide.


